





# Definitions for H.E.L.P. Experts

<p><b><u>H</u>istorian</b></p> 	<p>noun</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• an expert who studies history</li> <li>• a person who compiles a chronological record of events</li> <li>• a person who writes history, esp. one who is an authority on it</li> </ul> <p>(a branch of knowledge that records and explains past events) (history)</p>
<p><b><u>E</u>conomist</b></p> <p>\$</p>  <p>\$</p>	<p>noun</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• an expert who studies how individuals and societies choose to use resources; what goods and services to be produced, how they will produce them and how they will distribute them among the members of society</li> <li>• a person who studies financial considerations (money – resources – time, etc.)</li> </ul> <p>(the science that deals with the production, distribution and consumption of goods and services) (economics)</p>
<p><b><u>G</u>eographer</b></p> <p><b><u>L</u>ocation</b></p> 	<p>noun</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a person who studies the natural features of the earth's surface, including topography, climate, soil, vegetation, etc., and man's response to them</li> <li>• a person who studies the physical features of the earth and its atmosphere, and human activity and the effects of these</li> </ul> <p>(the science of the earth's physical features, resources, climate, population, etc.) (geography)</p>
<p><b><u>P</u>olitical Scientist</b></p> 	<p>noun</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• a person who studies local, state, national or international government</li> <li>• a person who studies government, public politics and political behavior</li> </ul> <p>(a science concerned chiefly with the description and analysis of political and governmental institutions and processes) (politics)</p>
